On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

3. **Ingredients Statement.** In the ingredients statement we recommend changing the term "Inert Ingredients" to "Other Ingredients".

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**4. First Aid:** Add the following the statement based on the reclassification of the acute inhalation study to EPA acute toxicity category 3.

“IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center immediately or doctor for immediate treatment advice.”

**5. Precautionary Statements.**

a. Add a referral statement to the front panel of the label, “Refer to back/side panel for additional precautions.”

**Revise the precautionary statements as follows:**


