The amended labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) as amended, for redesigned format to add emergency phone numbers and warranty statement and transfer of registration was reviewed and found to be acceptable providing you make the following labeling changes:

1. On page 1, the signal word must read "DANGER/PELIGRO". You must also add the following statement after the signal word "Si usted no etiende de la etiqueta, busque a alguien para que se la explique a usted en detalle. (If you do not understand the label, find someone to explain it to you in detail).

2. On page 2, in the Precautionary Statements; the last sentence "USEPA" must read "U.S. EPA".

3. Add this sentence to the Precautionary Statements on page 2, "Do not get in eyes or on clothing."

A copy of label stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed.

Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release your product for shipment.
