

DIRECTIONS

To Kill Roaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish: Spray generously around sinks, baseboards, refrigerator, forcing liquid in all cracks and crevices. To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, and Wasps: Spray Common Sense Fog or Spray freely in closed room until filled with mist. Direct spray toward ceiling. Leave room closed 10 to 15 minutes. Sweep dead insects; then open windows. To Kill Bed Bugs: Spray both sides of mattresses with Common Sense Fog or Spray: Force Common Sense Fog or Spray into seams and tufts. Spray cracks, crevices and baseboards where bugs lodge. Spray bed springs thoroughly and all cracks cracks and crevices in the bedstead. To Kill Spiders: Spray directly on webs and surrounding areas.

DIRECTIONS

Clothes Moths: Common Sense Fog or Spray will kill moths, larvae, chrysalis and eggs. Common Sense Fog or Spray must come in contact with eggs, larvae, and chrysalis. Spray Common Sense Fog or Spray generously in floor cracks and openings in baseboards. Wet walls and ceiling of closets to be de-mothed. Clothing to be stored should be cleaned, aired and sprayed carefully from a distance of 1 to 2 feet. See that seams and folds are wet. Chests and closets should be thoroughly sprayed before being filled with clothed. Clothing in closets or stored in chests which are not moth-tight should be sprayed monthly. To Kill Ants: Spray Generously, paying particular attention to runways, window sills, and door treads where ants enter the premises. To Kill Fleas: Spray liberally cracks and crevices in flooring and sleeping quarters of pets and floor coverings.

REPEAT ALL DIRECTIONS WHEN NECESSARY

DO NOT SPRAY NEAR OPEN FIRE.
