HILL'S PS-220 insecticide is a highly concentrated contact insecticide for use in Peanut Warehouses or where peanuts are stored or processed.

KILLS exposed stages of Confused Flour Beetles, Indian Meal Moths, Granary Weevils and certain other insects that infest stored peanuts.

DIRECTIONS

Thoroughly clean area to be sprayed by removing accumulations from cracks, corners and around all equipment. Spray empty bins before storing peanuts. Wet surfaces thoroughly and treat all infested surface areas, insect hiding places and insect runways at the ratio of 1½ gallons PS-220 on 1,000 square feet of area. Spray directly on the insects when possible and repeat application as often as necessary. **WHEN TO SPRAY - FOR STORED PEANUTS,** treat within seven days after first nuts are placed in storage. Spray evenly over entire surface of bulk or bag peanuts. Repeat as often as storage regulations require, or approximately at weekly intervals. In case of severe infestation spray daily.

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Do not spray into or near open flame. Keep container closed tightly. Store in cool place. Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame. Harmful if swallowed. Do not reuse empty container. Destroy it by perforating or crushing. Bury or discard in a safe place.
