Subject: Amendment - Name Change - Label Update  
Hill #212 Fly Bait  
EPA Registration No. 402-73  
Your Application Dated March 18, 1986

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. The wording "Die In Seconds" is too vague. You must stipulate the amount of time and provide data which support this claim. Otherwise, it must be deleted.
2. The name change from #212 Fly Bait to Hill #212 Fly Bait is acceptable and has been made part of the official record.
3. Delete the wording "Use a container of some kind." It is too vague.
4. Add the sentence "Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs" to the Precautionary Statements section.
5. Add the sentence "DDVP is a cholinesterase inhibitor" to the Note to Physician section. It should be the first sentence of this section.
6. Add the sentence "Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste" to the Environmental Hazards section.

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Birds feeding in water can be killed. Do not apply directly to any body of water.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

**IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.**

**As a Dry Bait:** Sprinkle lightly in areas where flies congregate. 1000 sq. ft. A faster kill may be achieved if applied to a surface.

**As a Liquid Bait:** Dissolve one (1) pound of dry bait in 100 gallons of water. Spray on walls, paint on silos, or use to make bait stations in farm buildings, bait stations can be made by placing a shallow pan or other absorbent material on a rodent bait station. Then sprinkle with FLY BAIT. Bait stations should be checked at regular intervals. Do not use as a spray in dairy barns.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product should be disposed of on site or at any approved waste disposal facility.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Completely empty bag into a container. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, as allowed by State, Federal and local authorities, but never by burning or out of smoke.
