The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, and a stamped copy is enclosed for your records. At the next printing of your label, or within 60 days, whichever comes first, please make the following changes:

1. Petroleum distillates are no longer considered to be active ingredients and must be removed from the active ingredients statement on the front panel. They should be included with the inert ingredients, and a footnote added to this line to indicate: "Contains petroleum distillates". The label statement should show the total amount of inert ingredients in the formulation to be 98.683%.
2. Several misspellings and typographical errors should be corrected:

"respiration" is misspelled in the Statement of Practical Treatment,

the Precautionary Statements paragraph should begin "Harmful if Swallowed",

the Use Restriction Statement should read "It is a violation...",

the directions for use on fleas, flies etc, should read "...spray infested areas".

The Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF), dated November 27, 1990, is acceptable and has been placed in our file for this product. This CSF supersedes all previous submissions and is expected to represent the current and only formulation for this product.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
