The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- a. In reference to our letter of August 14, 1984, item #3, you need to revise the diazinon declaration in the ingredients statement to read: Diazinon [O,O-diethyl-O-(2-isopropyl-6-methyl-4-pyrimidinyl) phosphorothioate].
- b. Please revise the Storage and Disposal statement per PR Notice 83-3.
- c. Your most recent label submission indicates that you have changed your product name to read No. 5028 Hilcobane Roach and Ant Spray. Our records have been changed to reflect this change.

3. Your claims for pyrethrins and piperonyl butoxide are slightly too high--the maximum should be 0.049 and 0.099, respectively. You have also revised other claims on the label to conform with our previous comments and not altered the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF). You therefore need to submit a corrected CSF for our records.

4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist or vapors. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. Wash thoroughly after using and before smoking or eating. Do not allow children or pets on treated areas until surface is dry. Do not use on household pets or humans.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

FLAMMABLE Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposed to temperatures above 130 degrees F. may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For spot application only. Do not use as a space spray.

Do not use in edible products areas of food processing plants, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

In the home, all food processing surfaces, exposed food and utensils, should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use.

Hold can upright and spray infested surfaces only until wet.

ROACHES, ANTS, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, CRICKETS Spray heavily into all cracks, around baseboards, and on places where these insects hide. In homes also spray until wet, surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and on baseboards. Spray other localized areas infested with these pests. Repeat as necessary.

FOR CONTROL OF SILVERFISH Treat around bookcases and storage areas. Repeat as necessary.

CARPET BEETLES Make localized application to areas of the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks and under carpets where insects may be found. Treat crevices, cracks, closets and infested areas of shelving. Repeat as necessary. Spray infested areas when observed.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, WASPS, AND FLYING MOTHS - OUTDOORS For outdoor use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages and other places where these insects light or congregate.

Do not use in commercial food processing or preparation areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces, exposed food and utensils, should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
