In making emulsions of Hy-Pine Disinfectant always add the water to the disinfectant rather than vice versa. If possible the water should be about 98°F. Prepare fresh daily.

For aid as ordinary disinfectant against Salmonella Choleraesuis, wash the contaminated area with a solution of 1 to 40. The surfaces must be thoroughly clean of all gross filth prior to application of product. Wet surfaces thoroughly with Hy-Pine Disinfectant solution and allow to remain on surface for 10 minutes. Rinse well after use.
