# MINT DISINFECTANT

Coefficient 5

Active Ingredients . . . . . 35.5%  
 Isopropanol, Anhydrous Vegetable Oil Soap, Methyl Salicylate, o-benzyl-p-chlorophenol, p-tertiary-amyl-phenol, 4-chloro-2-phenylphenol, 6-chloro-2-phenylphenol, o-phenylphenol.

Inert Ingredients . . . . . 64.5%  
 Water

**A DISINFECTANT AND DEODORANT FOR GENERAL USE AS A WASH FOR TOILETS, FLOORS, GARBAGE PAILS, SINKS, WALLS, FLOORS OF SHEDS, outhouses, AND AROUND SWIMMING POOLS, SCHOOLS AND FACTORIES.**

## DIRECTIONS

Remove all loose dirt, litter and other debris before applying solutions of this disinfectant. Apply so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly.

**URINALS, TOILETS, LOCKER ROOMS and LOCKER SHOWERS:** (For Toilet Bowls see below). Clean daily with a solution of 1 part disinfectant in 40 parts water. Wet down walls, floors, and shower stalls thoroughly. When finished, pour the solution down drains to deodorize them.

**PUBLIC PLACES:** For Schools, Hotels, Motels, Theatres, Stores, Office Buildings, Institutions—spray freely as a solution of 1 part disinfectant in 40 parts water so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly and to cover all areas of contamination.

**To DEODORIZE CLOSET BOWLS and TOILET BOWLS:** Flush bowl prior to application of the deodorizing solution. Clean and flush hopper daily with a solution of 1 part product in 40 parts water. This solution should also be used in the bowl and for washing the seat and lid.

**GARBAGE RECEPTACLES:** To check the development of putrefactive action and to aid in checking the breeding of flies, spray the garbage in the receptacles and also around the receptacles with a solution of 1 part disinfectant in 40 parts water. Leave some of the solution in the can.

**WARNING: Keep Out of Reach of Children.** Corrosive. May cause eye damage. Causes severe skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

**FIRST AID:** In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
