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DIRECTIONS:

Dilute at rate of 1 to 2 gallons Hill's Mal-Ron #1241 Fogging Concentrate to 25 gallons #2 fuel oil. Envelop area to be treated with a fog or fine spray. Apply at a rate of 2 gallons diluted spray per acre. For control of mosquitoes apply at a use dilution of 1 gallon MAL-RON #1241 to 12 gallons of #2 fuel oil. DO NOT USE, POUR, SPILL OR STORE NEAR HEAT OR OPEN FLAME.

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN
