Dilute at rate of 1 to 2 gallons Hill #1241 Mal-Ron Fogging Concentrate to 25 gallons #2 fuel oil. Envelop area to be treated with a fog or fine spray. Apply at a rate of 2 gallons diluted spray per acre. For control of mosquitoes apply at a use dilution of 1 gallon #1242 Mal-Ron to 12 gallons of #2 fuel oil
