DIRECTIONS

Place Rat and Mouse Killer in a protected spot where the rats and mice ordinarily feed and water, or where they travel or live.

Use shallow containers for the bait. Bait should be placed in locations not accessible to children, pets, and domestic animals or in tamper proof bait boxes. For RATS use one or two bait placements (1/4 to 1 pound each) at every point of large activity . . . look for such tell-tale signs as gnawings, tracks or trails, burrows, droppings, or damage. For MICE a larger number of bait placements (about 1 tablespoon each) should be made at 8 to 12 foot intervals. An uninterrupted supply of bait should be maintained for at least 15 days.

KEEP FEEDING STATIONS WELL SUPPLIED. Inspect and replenish each station daily for the first week and regularly thereafter until bait is no longer being taken. Never allow a feeding station to remain empty for over 48 hours. If some bait stations are untouched, move to a different location. If baits become sour or moldy (as might be the case during extended periods of hot humid weather), replace with fresh bait as needed. Where re-infestation from dumps and fields may occur, permanent Rat and Mouse Killer stations should be set out and replenished as needed.

AN EFFECTIVE CHEMICAL FOR RODENT CONTROL: Rat and Mouse Killer contains an anticoagulant

chemical. Its remarkable killing power depends on its being consumed regularly in small doses for a period of days -- usually 10 - 15 days.

CAUTION

If swallowed by humans, domestic animals, or pets, this material may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause bleeding. In such case, intravenous and oral administration of Vitamin K combined with blood transfusions may be indicated, as in the case of hemorrhage caused by overdoses of bishydroxycoumarin.
