Imperial Tomato Dust may be applied to moist or dry foliage any time when dusting conditions are favorable. Begin applications soon after plants are above the ground or when disease conditions threaten or insects first appear. Apply at 5 to 10 day intervals or oftener if disease conditions become severe. Apply a light even coating of dust to both upper and lower leaf surfaces.

IMPORTANT: Keep foliage covered, especially new growth.

USE TOMATO DUST ON:

TOMATOES—For Early and Late Blight, Anthracnose, Septoria Leaf as anended, and Rederal Insecticide, Tomato Fruit Worm, Tomato Hornworm, Yellow Striped Army registered under the pesticide At Property of the Posticide At Property

Do not use on Tomatoes within 5 days of harvest.

PEPPERS, EGGPLANTS—Flea Beetle, Leafhopper, Colorado Potato Beetle, Aphids, Tarnished Plant Bug. Anthracnose and Cercospora on peppers and Phomopsis, Alternaria and Anthracnose on eggplants.
