**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

- IF SWALLOWED** - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.
- IF INHALED** - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
- IF ON SKIN** - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
- IF IN EYES** - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhaling dust. Avoid contamination of foodstuffs and feed. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. May be absorbed through skin, and dust may irritate nasal membrane. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking.

Consumption of alcoholic beverages increase the toxic effects of thiram.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Drift or runoff from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands.

This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or to residues remaining on the treated area. Do not apply when bees are actively visiting the crop, cover crop, or weeds blooming in the treatment area. Applications should be timed to provide the maximum possible interval between treatment and the next period of bee activity.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply this product in such a manner as to directly or through drift expose workers or other persons. The area being treated must be vacated by unprotected persons.  
Do not enter treated areas without protective clothing until dusts have settled.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container, in a cool, dry, secure area, away from fertilizer, food or feed. Keep container closed.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste Representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty bag into application equipment; then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

Applicators must wear the following protective clothing during the application process: long-sleeved shirt, long pants. Wear a disposable dust mask covering 1/3 of face or more.

Apply dust to bulbs after they are cleaned (as you put them in storage.)

Gladiolus bulbs that are treated with this product must bear distinct labeling that instructs:

CAUTION: Treated with thiram. Wear rubber gloves and protective clothing when handling products treated with thiram. Direct exposure to skin may result in severe dermatitis.

Do not rotate treated crop with crops other than those with registered thiram uses. Do not reenter treated areas within 24 hours following application unless protective clothing is worn.

GLADIOLUS--

Dust twice a week from early stages until spikes begin to open for control of the following insects and diseases: Thrips, Botrytis, Curvularia, Stemphylium. Repeat as necessary. Continue dusting every 7 to 10 days as long as insects are present.

ALSO RECOMMENDED FOR USE ON THESE:

Azaleas, Camellias: To control Petal Blight, apply as least twice a week while flowers are opening. Also apply to soil and litter around the plants while the flowers are in bloom. Repeat every 7 to 10 days for insect control.

Carnations, Chrysanthemums, Hollyhocks, Snapdragons: To control rust, Leaf Spot, and Anthracnose, apply as soon as disease threatens. Repeat every 7 to 10 days or as often as necessary to keep new foliage protected.

Roses: For control of Black Spot, dust at 7 to 10 day intervals and after every rain. For best results, apply before plants become affected.
