

Directions For Use

For general use in cattle, oler to control horn flies and as an aid in the control of lice and face flies on beef cattle and dairy cattle through the summer and winter months. Dilute this product in water for application to the animal. Do not mix with water for use in the area of the backrubber. The backrubber should be located in an area that will allow cattle free access to the mechanism. These areas would include heating areas, feed lots, or salt licks.

Initially charge or saturate the oiler with diluted material when placed and repeat in 10 to 14 days or as needed to give insect control.

Backrubber may be used anytime on beef or dairy cattle.

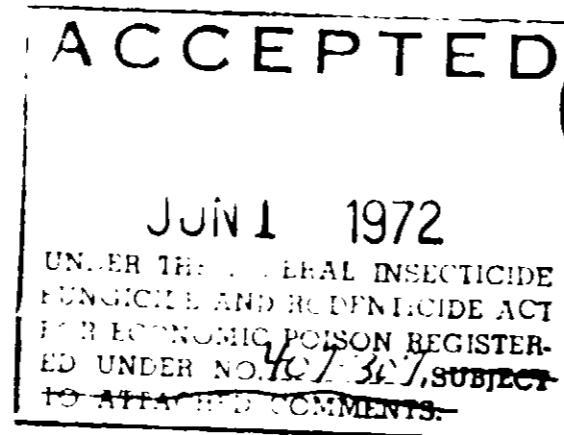
