

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage and Cauliflower. Root Maggots. Broadcast 5-7½ oz. per 1,000 sq. ft. (½-¾ oz. per 100 sq. ft.) before planting or transplanting. Work into soil 3-4 inches.

Onions. Onion Maggots. Apply 5-10 oz. per 1,000 sq. ft. (½-1 oz. per 100 sq. ft.) as a broadcast soil treatment just prior to planting. Work into soil 3-4 inches.

Kadishes. Root Maggots: Apply 5-5 oz. per 1,000 sq. ft. (½-½ oz. per 100 sq. ft.) or ½ oz. per 100 lineal feet of row in seed furrow at planting time.

Potatoes. Cutworms: (Surface and Subterranean) Broadcast 5-10 oz. per 1,000 sq. ft. (½-1 oz. per 100 sq. ft.) before planting. Work into soil 4-6 inches. Wireworms. Broadcast 7½-15 oz. per 1,000 sq. ft. (¾-1½ oz. per 100 sq. ft.) before planting. Work into soil 4-8 inches.

Sweet Corn. Corn Rootworm Larvae: Apply 8½-17 oz. per 1,000 ft. of linear row in a 7 inch band centered over row at time of planting. Cutworms: Broadcast 5-10 oz. per 1,000 sq. ft. (½-1 oz. per 100 sq. ft.) For surface cutworms apply just prior to planting and work in to soil 1-2 inches. For subterranean cutworms apply just prior to planting and work into soil 3-6 inches. Seed Corn Maggots: Broadcast 5-10 oz. per 1,000 sq. ft. (½-1 oz. per 100 sq. ft.) before planting. Work into soil 2 inches.

Cutworms: (Surface and Subterranean) Preplant only. For Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Muskmelons, Cauliflower, Celery, Collards, Cucumbers, Kale, Lettuce, Lima Beans, Cantaloupes, Parsley, Peas, Peppers, Pole Beans, Snap Beans, Spinach, Summer and Winter Squash, Swiss Chard, Tomatoes, and Watermelons broadcast 5-10 oz. per 1,000 sq. feet, (½-1 oz. per 100 sq. ft.). Work into soil 2-3 inches for surface cutworms, 3-6 inches for subterranean cutworms.


Wireworms: For Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Carrots, Cantaloupes, Cauliflower, Celery, Collards, Cucumbers, Kale, Lettuce, Lima Beans, Muskmelons, Onions, Parsley, Peas, Peppers, Pole and Snap Beans, Spinach, Summer and Winter Squash, Sweet Potatoes, Swiss Chard, Tomatoes, and Watermelons broadcast 7½-10 oz. per 1,000 sq. ft. (¾-1 oz. per 100 sq. ft.) before planting. Work into soil 4-8 inches.

Lawn Cincl. Bugs, Sod Webworm, Cutworms, Lawn Billbugs (see note): Apply ½-1 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. (2½-5 lbs. per 5,000 sq. ft.) and rake lawn to work granules down to soil surface. Do not water lawn for 1-2 days following application. Repeat in 7-10 days, if necessary. For dense growing grass such as St. Augustine grass, use 1-1½ lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. (5-7½ lbs. per 5,000 sq. ft.) and apply using the same procedure. Keep children and pets off treated areas until this material is washed into the soil and grass is dry. **Note:** for lawn billbugs water lawn thoroughly immediately after treatment.
