TOMATOES: For anthracnose, early and late blights, grey leaf spot (stemphylium), septoria leaf spot, and the insects tomato fruitworm, yellow striped armyworm, aphids, spider mites, tomato russet mite, leafhoppers, apply at the rate of .1 lb. per 100 square feet (1.5 oz.). Do not use on tomatoes within 7 days of harvest.
