The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. Under Statement of Practical Treatment, and the Note to Physician as follows:

Note to Physician: Coumaphos is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

- Under cattle instructions for Direct Application, modify 2. the statement "repeat as necessary" as follows: "Repeat as necessary but not more than often than every 14 days."
- 3. Add the following statement under the dust bag directions for use:

Manage the dispenser bag so as not to apply more than 1 or dust per animal per day.

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Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

## BEEF AND DAIRY CATTLE

DUST BAG - Place the contents of this package in any conmercially available dust bag. Suspend bags in areas frequented by cattle or in gateways or lanes through which the animals pass daily for water, feed or minerals. Do not hang bags directly over feed, minerals or water. Bags may also be suspended in loafing sheds or in front of protected mineral feeders. For lactating dairy cows, bags may be suspended in the exit through which the cows leave the milking barn. In all cases, the bags should be adjusted so that the bottom of the bag will hang 4" - 6" below the top line of the animals treated. As an aid in controlling face flies, bags rist be located so that animals will be forced to use them daily and hung at a height to insure that the faces of the animals will be dusted.

### To control horn flies and lice

DIRECT APPLICATION - This product may be applied by use of a shaker can or by using a suitable mechanical duster. Apply not more than 2 ounces (4 level tablespoons) of dust per animal by shaker can or suitable mechanical duster over the head, neck, shoulders, back and tailhead. Repeat as necessary. No interval is required between treatment and use of meat or milk as food.

### To control lice

DIRECT APPLICATION - Apply not more than 1 ounce (2 level tablespoons) per head as a uniform coat to the head, shoulders, and back by use of a shaker can or suitable mechanical duster. Repeat as necessary but not more often than once every 10 days. No interval is required between treatment and use of meat as food.

BEDDING TREATMENT - Apply 2 ounces (4 level tablespoons) uniformly over each 30 sq. ft. of fresh, dry bedding by use of a shaker can or suitable mechanical duster. Repeat as necessary but not more often than once every 10 days.

DIRECT APPLICATION AND BEDDING TREATMENT: In severe infestations both individual animals and bedding may be treated as directed above.
