CAUTION

STORAGE: Store in a secure area, in original container only, away from fertilizers, food or feed.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

Applicators must wear the following protective clothing during the application process; a light-weight protective suit or coveralls; water-resistant hat; unlined, waterproof gloves; and unlined, light-weight boots. Mixers and loaders must also wear goggles or a face shield; waterproof gloves and a waterproof apron.

For the control of sarcoptic mange, and as an aid in the control of lice on hogs, especially in the winter when the use of a dip is not advised. Simply disperse a visible coating of the powder over the animal to be treated by means of a dust gun or shaker can. Treat the animal and its quarters. If it is desired simply suspend the powder in water at the rate of one-half pound of powder to each gallon of water. Spray areas of heavy infestation. Do not treat sows within 2 weeks of farrowing nor for at least 3 weeks after. Do not spray animals in cold, stormy weather. Avoid treating emaciated or sick animals. Do not treat animals under 2 weeks of age.

Do not apply spray or dust within 100 feet of slaughter.

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for distribution bearing the amended labeling:

1. Revise the Restricted Use Pesticide block to read:

For retail sale to and use by **Certified Applicators** or persons under their direct supervision and only for those uses covered by the Certified Applicator certification.

2. You refer to the release of a pesticide as "application" in the correct print size for the front panel of each can, child safety cap, and the label. Change "application" to "release" and "release" to "application" wherever appropriate.

3. Change "application" to "release" in the "Directions" and "Precautions" sections.

4. The following changes are required for the label to be in compliance with the FIFRA Act and the regulations thereunder. Amend the label as follows:

- Revise the "Directions for Use" section to read:  
"Directions for Use: Mix with water."
- Revise the pesticide disposal text to read:

Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the hazardous waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

- 7. Revise the young animal restriction to read: "Do not treat young animals under 3 months of age."

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

**A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.**

If you hold a Federal registration, a supplemental registration, or a Special Local Needs registration, you may continue to produce new stocks of such products, using current labeling, until April 1, 1984. After that date, all remaining inventories of affected products will fall under the Existing Stocks provisions stated in our letter of October 28, 1983.
