STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal STORAGE Store only in original container, in a dry place inaccess. ble to children and pets

DISPOSAL. Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash

USE RESTRICTIONS: For control of Norway rats, roof rats, and house mice in and around homes, industrial and agricultural buildings an similar man-made structures and inside transport vehicles (ships barges, railcars, aircraft)

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS. Determine areas where rats/mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these

areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in local tions where rodents or their signs have been observed. Protect bait from rain or snow. Remove as much of any other food source as possible

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS.

Treated baits must be placed in tamper proof bait boxes or in locations not accessible to children pets, domestic animals, or wildlife Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food of surfaces that come in direct contact with food

FOR RATS -- Place 4 to 16 oz of bait per placement. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days.

FOR MICE - Place '4 to '2 oz (1 to 2 level tablespoons) of bait at 8 to 12 foot intervals. Larger placements (up to 2 oz) may be needed at points of very high mouse actions. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days

Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all dead animals and unconsumed bait properly. To prevent reinfestation, eliminate food, water, and harborage as much as possible if reinfestation does occur inepeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is near, such as a dump or uncontrolled area such as an abandoned building establish permanent bait stations and replenish bait as needed
