DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Shake can before use. Hold can about one inch away from area to be treated. Press valve to release a puff of lather about the size of a golf ball. Rub foam into coat and towel off with terry-cloth toweling. Do only one area at a time until entire coat is cleaned. Thirty minutes after cleaning comb and brush the dog's coat to remove dead fleas and ticks and also to give the coat a glossy sheen.
