

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Screwworm and Blowfly Infestations: Apply with swah or brush, working into deep pockets. Also spread smear around and over drainage area below wound. Re-treat if necessary. Freely bleeding wounds may require several applications.

To Prevent Screwworm and Blowfly Infestations: Treat fresh wounds resulting from dehorning, castrations, shear cuts, etc. Also treat navels of newborn animals. Re-treat as needed.

Fleece Worm and Other Blowfly Infestations: Mix one part Blue Smear Screwworm Killer with nine parts water. Apply as a wash on and around infested areas.

Ear tick and ear mite control: Pour unuiluted smear in ears or apply with a brush or swab.
