HOW TO APPLY: Sheep should be treated at
 shearing time, weaning, or in the fall, and
 in a well ventilated area. Apply the recom-
 mended dose of **FRANKLIN DURSBAN 44** to one
 spot to the top midline area of the animal,
 just below the shoulder blades and neck
 junction.

AMOUNT TO USE: Use **FRANKLIN DURSBAN 44** for
 lice and horn fly control on cattle and
 key control on sheep at the rate of 2cc per
 100 lbs. of animal body weight up to 500 lbs.
 For animals weighing more than 500 lbs. use
 not more than 16cc per 100 lbs. of body
 weight. The amount of material required is
 applied to the proper dose.

USE PRECAUTIONS

CATTLE

DO NOT TREAT • Bulls over 8 months of age of any breed • Purebred continental or
 exotic breed cattle such as Simmental, Charolais or Gelbsch • Dairy breed
 cattle of any age • Cows within 21 days prior to or 14 days after calving • Veal calves
 • Beef breed calves under 12 weeks of age
 Dairy, Brahman, continental or exotic breed cattle crossed with beef breeds (British)
 may be treated.
 Do not treat sick, convalescent or severely stressed animals.
 Do not treat cattle for 10 days before or after shipping, dehorning, castration, vaccina-
 tion, etc.
 Do not slaughter animals within 14 days of initial treatment. If reinfestation does
 occur, animals may be re-treated according to the following schedule: (1) 14 days
 after initial treatment with a 14 day withdrawal prior to slaughter or (2) 20 days after
 initial treatment with a 21 day withdrawal prior to slaughter. Do not re-treat animals
 within less than 30 days.

Lambs weighing LESS than 50 lbs.

Do not slaughter sheep within 35 days of treatment.

DO NOT RETREAT
