USE PRECAUTIONS

CATTLE
DO NOT TREAT • Beef breed animals under 200 lbs. or 12 weeks of age • Bulls over 8 months of age of any breed • Purebred continental or exotic breed cattle such as Simmental, Charolais, Charolais or Gelbvieh, etc. • Dairy-breed cattle of any age • Cows 30 days before or after calving • Veal calves
Dairy, Brahma, continental or exotic breed cattle crossed with beef breeds (British) may be treated.
Do not slaughter animals within 14 days of treatment. If reinfestation does occur animals may be re-treated but not within 45 days of initial treatment.
Do not brand animal with a hot iron while treating with FRANKLIN DURSBAN 44. The solvent system is combustible and could cause a serious burn to the animals.

FRANKLIN DURSBAN 44 insecticide is a convenient "one-shot" treatment to provide season-long control of biting and sucking lice. FRANKLIN DURSBAN 44 is not effective against cattle grubs. Cattle may be treated during any season of the year for lice and horn fly control. FRANKLIN DURSBAN 44 provides for control of horn flies up to 8 weeks. Sheep should be treated at shearing time.

HOW TO APPLY: Wearing rubber gloves, and in a well ventilated area, pour the required dose of FRANKLIN DURSBAN 44 in one spot to the top midline area of the animal, just behind the shoulder blades and neck junction.

AMOUNT TO USE: Use FRANKLIN DURSBAN 44 at the rate of 2 ml. per 100 lbs. of animal body weight up to 800 lb. For animals weighing more than 800 lbs., use no more than 16 ml. Due to the small amount of material required, care must be taken to apply the proper dose.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Waste resulting from use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
