PIONEER TREE WOUND DRESSING is a medium black liquid of brushing consistency. When applied properly, it forms a watertight coating over the wound, preventing rot and helping prevent insect activity in the wound. CAUTION: Harmful if taken internally.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
IMPORTANT: Stir contents thoroughly before using. Keep container tightly covered when not in use.
APPLICATION: A clean paint brush is suitable for application for all practical purposes.
PRUNING: During pruning, remove all disease and insect eaten wood until sound, uninfected wood is reached. Pruning stubs should be cut as close as possible to their point of attachment. When the exposure is clear and clean, apply generous coating of PIONEER TREE WOUND DRESSING.
