

## **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

IMPORTANT: Read the entire directions, including the Warrantv and cautions, before using Pioneer Bagworm Spray.

Pioneer Bagworm Spray provides plants with two-way protection from insect attack. The spray kills specified insects on contact. In addition, Pioneer Bagworm Spray is absorbed by the leaves and

In addition, Pioneer Bagworm Spray is absorbed by the leaves and moves in the sap stream to all parts of the plant (systemic action). Working from inside the plant, the insecticide kills specified sucking insects that feed on the plant sap.

PROTECT YOUR ORNAMENTAL FLOWERS, SHRUBS, AND TREES FROM INSECT DAMAGE.

MIXING DIRECTIONS: The spray mixes readily with water and may be used in all types of sprayers. Use 4 tablespoonfuls (2 fluid oz.) of Pioneer Bagworm Spray for each gallon of water. Spray plants until they are thoroughly wet. Repeat applications as necessary to maintain insect control.

For hose-end sprayers, measure 4 tab'espoons into the sprayer jar for each gallon of final spray. Add water to the indicated level in the jar to give the desired number of gallons of final spray.

CAUTION: Plant injury from Pioneer Bagwom Spray applications has been observed on Royal Purple Smoke trees and on certain varieties of carnations and zinnias. For these three kinds of plants, treat only a few plants and observe for 4 to 5 days before spraying the entire planting.

Do not handle treated plants until the spray deposit has dried.

Do not use on plants used for food or forage. Use only according to label directions.


CAUTION: Pioneer Bagworm Spray is toxic to bees and should not be applied when bees are actively visiting area.

Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label. Do not re-use container for any purpose. Destroy empty container. Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame.
