FOR USE AS A DISINFECTANT IN LIVESTOCK BUILDINGS

Using one quart of Disinfectant to nine gallons of water, follow the procedure as listed below:

1. Remove all livestock from building to be treated with the Disinfectant. Destroy or remove animal feeds from the premises.
2. Thoroughly clean and protect or remove from the building all equipment, including feeders and waterers. Remove all litter or bedding and clean the building thoroughly.
3. Apply Disinfectant only at recommended rate. When feeding and watering equipment are disinfected, thoroughly scrub with detergent and rinse with potable water.
4. Ventilate the building and do not house livestock until treatment has been absorbed, set, and dried.
5. Do not make any Disinfectant applications when animals are in the building.
