Crab Lice - Apply with pad over affected parts, and repeat after fifteen minutes. To remove lice and nits, wash with warm water and soap, and use fine comb.

Body Lice- Treat as for crab lice.

Head Lice and Nits- Apply freely to the scalp and hair. Rub in with fingers. Allow it to dry. One thorough application is usually effective. However, repeating two or three times within two days will aid in quicker riddance.

Chiggers-Apply with hand, cloth pad or cotton and rub thoroughly into the affected parts. Repeat application in five minutes, which will aid in relieving infestation.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
