DIRECTIONS FOR USE

suitable portable thermal applicator equipment that can deliver spray parti-
cle sizes within the aerosol size range.

FOR OUTDOOR USE ONLY

For small area applications. Hold thermal applicator at least five feet
from any object especially plants and shrubbery. Avoid wetting of
soil. Apply undiluted at the rate of 1 to 2 oz. per 1000 cu. ft. Fog only
when there is no breeze, or the wind velocity is less than 3 miles per
hour. The ideal time is generally at dusk when the wind dies down and
the air temperature and ground temperature are approximately the
same. Under these conditions the fog will linger in the treated area for a
longer time. Apply fog while moving away from treated area. Keep away
from Food, Humans and Pets. Avoid inhalation of the fog. DO NOT
SMOKE WHILE FOGGING. Do not enter the treated area until the fog has
dissipated. Repeat application as necessary.
