Subject: RESMETHRIN Registration Standard Label Revision
CENOL KILL QUICK FOGGING SPRAY SBP-1382
EPA Registration Number 419-178
Submission dated April 2, 1991

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. Revise the total inert ingredient percentage declaration on the label to include the "Related Compounds" percentage. Do not list "Related Compounds" separately as an active ingredient.
2. Remove "picnic areas, campsites, and drive-ins" from the OUTDOORS use statement. If these designations are not removed from the label, the product must be labeled RESTRICTED USE as indicated in the RESMETHRIN Standard.
3. If the uses cited in number 2 are deleted, revise the ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS statement to read:

"This product is highly toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes, and potholes). Drift and runoff from treated sites may be hazardous to fish in adjacent waters. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters."

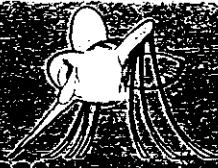
