The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. Within the Environmental Hazards section, correct the typographical error from "ivashwaters" to "washwaters."
2. The marketing attribute word "POWERFUL" located on the front panel, and on the side panel below the words "MOSQUITO FOG". are considered false and misleading claims in accordance with 40 CFR 156.10.

Implied claims (e.g., any statement, design, graphic representation or brand name) of heightened efficacy of a pesticide product by itself or as compared with another product or device are false and misleading. Examples of such claims include, but are not limited to: "professional strength," "extermination strength," "hospital strength," "industrial strength," "institutional strength," "super strength," "ultra strength," "maximum strength," "maximum efficacy," "extra strength," "double-strength," "triple-strength," "hospital grade," "high potency," and "high-powered". You may further reference PR Notice 93-6 for guidance on the use of such terms.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This formulation is to be used undiluted in only such portable thermal applicator equipment that can deliver spray particle size within the aerosol micron size range.

FOR OUTDOOR FOGGING USE ONLY

IDEAL FOR PATIOS; YARDS; around POOLS; WAREHOUSES, RESTAURANTS, and in *HORSE STABLES, (not for application if horses are to be used for food). For small area applications. Hold thermal applicator at least five feet from any object, especially plants and shrubbery. Avoid wetting of foliage. Apply undiluted at the rate of 1 to 2 ounces, per 1,000 cubic feet. Fog only when there is no breeze, or the wind velocity is less than 3 miles per hour. The ideal time is generally at dusk when the wind dies down and the air temperature and ground temperature are approximately the same.
