STORAGE & DISPOSAL

1 PROHIBITIONS — DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER, FOOD OR FEED BY STORAGE, DISPOSAL OR CLEANING OF EQUIPMENT. OPEN DUMPING IS PROHIBITED.

Pesticide spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal, State, or local procedures.

Metal Containers — Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved state and local procedures.

Plastic Containers — Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

HOW TO USE: Apply with a low pressure sprayer equipped with a coarse spray nozzle. Spray surfaces only until wet. Avoid excessive run-off. Apply to all insect breeding sites and harborages. Not to be used as a mosquito larvicide. Also treat adjacent exposed surfaces where insects may crawl when they come out of hiding. Repeat treatment as necessary.

COCKROACHES — Thoroughly treat the infested area. Spray baseboard, cracks and crevices around window and door frames, under surfaces of shelves, drawers and work tables, behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks and stoves, in and around waste containers, switch panels, junction boxes and floor drains.

ANTS — Apply to trails and places where ants enter premises, such as window and door frames, spray hills and runways outdoors.

CADELLES, CIGARETTE BEETLES, DRUG STORE BEETLES, INDIAN MEAL MOTHS, MEDITERRANEAN FLOUR MOTHS, RED FLOUR BEETLES, SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES (EXPOSED STAGES) — Thoroughly treat floors and walls of the infested area with attention to cracks, crevices, corners and perimeters. Sanitation and dust control are of primary importance. Investigate or destroy infested products.

SILVERFISH, FIREBRATS AND PAPER LICE — Apply to localized areas infested by these insects.

BROWN DOG TICKS — Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames,

wall cracks, and local areas of floors. Repeat as needed. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarter after spraying. Do not spray animals.

CLOVER MITES, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, MILLIPEDES, CENTIPEDES, SOW BUGS, SCORPIONS AND SPIDERS — Thoroughly spray the interior and exterior perimeter of the infested premises. For CLOVER MITES, give special attention to window frames.

FLEAS, FLIES, GNATS, MOSQUITOES, PUNKIES AND SAND FLIES (outdoors only) — Spray infested areas thoroughly, including outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, foundations, patios and other areas where insects may enter.

FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS — Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served.

NON-FOOD AREAS Includes garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling). Apply to baseboard areas around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter.

INSECT CONTROL IN RESEARCH FACILITIES — The use of PRENTOX RESIDUAL SPRAY in and around research animal quarters for insect control will not induce changes in liver microsomal enzyme activity in these animals.
