PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin. In case of contact, immediately flush eye or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention for all exposures.

Do not apply directly to food containers in food handling facilities. Cover or remove any food in food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is underway. After application, clean up thoroughly. Ants, cockroaches and other food processing pests, wash equipment, bottles, shelving etc. where exposed food will be handled, with potable water. In the home, all food processing surfaces and food oils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Combustible liquid. Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame. Do not puncture or generate heat. Exposure to temperatures above 131 F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

This is a form of household use. Use this product in a manner consistent with its labeling.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place, away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

NOTE: Wear eye protection. Do not use until label is removed prior to treatment. Ventilate for two days after treatment. Do not use in areas where children play until after ventilation.

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Webbing Clothes Moths, and Gnats: Close windows and doors. Turn sprayer upward. In center of room, with a slow sweeping motion spray 5 to 10 seconds. Then sweep up. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly. Then re-spray. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Before spraying cover exposed electrical outlets.

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants, and Crickets: Contact as many insects as possible directly with the spray. In addition, spray into all parts of the room suspected of harbouring these pests. Spray into cracks, crevices, under sinks, behind stoves and behind doors. Check under desks and wherever the pests are suspected of hiding. For cockroaches, spray into wall voids and trails in other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary for re-treatment.

To Kill Carpet Beetles: Insecticide is highly effective. Spray both in floor and perimeter of carpet. Areas of carpet along bottom of steps and thresholds should be sprayed thoroughly. After the carpet is dry, there is no further treatment whatever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Exposed Forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Lesser Grain Borer, and Rice Weevils: In addition, spray into the flour bags. Remove all other pests from premises. Seal the flour bags. Carry out the insects to a secure place. Place clean paper on the stove to prevent particles of insecticide from being dried. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Wasps: Contact wasps directly with spray. Sweep up and destroy fallen wasps. Repeat as necessary.
