

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Cenol Phenolic Disinfectant is a powerful, highly concentrated, emulsifying disinfectant, and should be diluted with water as directed below.

For best results, use warm water. Cold or hard water retards the forming of an emulsion. Cold or hard water should be softened by the use of flake or chipped soap in proportion of about 2 ounces of soap chips to five gallons of water. Add Disinfectant in proper proportion after the soap is dissolved in water.

The use of soap in this Disinfectant does not harm or reduce the killing power of the product.

GENERAL USE—Three to four tablespoons of Disinfectant to one quart of warm water or one quart to about 30 quarts of warm water.

APPLICATION—Mop, scrub, spray, or sprinkle this solution liberally on surface to be treated.

TOILET BOWLS—To disinfect and deodorize, add 4 ounces of Disinfectant to water in toilet bowl. Allow it to stand for at least one hour. Swab entire inner surface of bowl and flush.

CAUTION: DO NOT USE IN MILK ROOMS, MILKING PARLORS, AND DAIRY BARNs.

DANGER: May be fatal if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. May produce severe burns. Do not get in eyes, or skin, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water and apply vaseline. Avoid breathing spray mist. Keep away from food. Keep out of reach of children and animals.

Rinse equipment and containers and dispose of wastes by burying in non-crop lands away from water supplies. Containers should be disposed by punching holes in them and burying with wastes.

DIRECTIONS

FLOORS: When mopping, scrub, or sweep, use 1/2 cupful in the bucket.

DISINFECTING: Remove all filth and dirt from surface. Add 1/2 cupful of Pine Oil Disinfectant to 100 parts of water. This mixture is used on floors, walls and woodwork.

TOILET ROOMS, WATER CLOSETS AND URINALS: Clean with a solution made of 1/3 cupful of Pine Oil Disinfectant in the bowl as long as possible. Scrub the floor.

GARBAGE: To aid in preventing the breeding of flies, add 1 1/2 ounces of Pine Oil Disinfectant to each gallon.
