DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For Use As a Disinfectant-Cleaner in Hospitals, Nursing Homes, Restaurants, Food Processing Plants, Schools and Public Buildings: WINTER-PHENE should always be diluted with water before using, as the use of the concentrated disinfectant may cause irritation to the skin.
