## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**Hospitals:** For disinfecting surgical instruments, use a 4% solution or approximately six ounces in each gallon of water. Instruments should be freed of all adhering blood and serous exudate prior to immersion in the disinfecting solution.

**For Disinfecting Bed Utensils, Etc.:** Use same strength solution.

~~As an Antiseptic Dressing for Wounds: For sores, skin abrasions, wounds, etc., use a 4% solution, applying same to the wound with gauze or absorbent cotton saturated in the solution.~~
