For Disinfecting In:
RESTAURANTS, TAVERNS, FOUNTAINS: First wash glasses, dishes, utensils and cooking equipment in a detergent cleaning solution which does not contain soap. Preferably rinse first with clear water, then rinse again for not less than 30 seconds in a solution containing 2 ounces of Quaternary Ammonium Germicide to each 2 gallons of water. Rinse with potable water. Always allow equipment to air dry. Do not towel.

DAIRIES, FOOD PLAN'S, PACKING HOUSES AND FOOD LOCKERS: Suriaces to be disinfected should first be thoroughly cleaned with a soapless cleaner. Then use 1 ounce of Quaternary Ammonium Germicide to 1 gallon of water as a spray or rinse for all working surfaces as well as walls, to control bacteria growth. Work tables, meat blocks and other places with which food may come in contact should be rinsed with clear water after disinfecting.

DEODORIZING REFUSE CONTAINERS, LOCKER ROOMS, DAMP BASEMENTS: Use 2 ounces of Quaternary Ammonium Germicide in $1 / 2$ gallon of water and spray over garbage and around toilet rooms. This will destroy objectionable odors without leaving a "disinfectant" smell behind.
