

DEODORIZER-AIR SANITIZER FOR HOSPITALS, HOTELS, INSTITUTIONS, SCHOOLS, OFFICES, MOTELS, HOMES

DIRECTIONS

BATH ROOMS: After routine cleaning of fixtures spray GLYCO-MIST AEROSOL on toilet bowl, seat, lavatory, tub, or shower stall thoroughly

KITCHENS, HOUSEHOLD CLEANING: Spray GLYCO-MIST AEROSOL freely in kitchen and other places in the home as an air sanitizer after routine cleaning operations. Spray kitchen equipment and on rugs, draperies, mattresses and stored clothing to eliminate foul, stale or musty odors.

DEODORIZING: Spray Mist into the atmosphere to remove obnoxious odors from smoke, cooking, refuse, body odors, etc.

Always hold dispenser upright. Point opening away from face when pressing button.

It will keep sick-rooms, meeting rooms, etc. with a refreshingly clean and sanitized odor that lingers for many hours.

HOUSEHOLD PETS: Spray lightly on pets to remove "animal" odors.

CAUTION: Do not set dispenser on stoves or radiators, or store in hot places. Do not puncture the container. This package should not be refilled but should be discarded after it is empty. Avoid contamination of food. Do not wet varnished or painted surfaces with this spray. Avoid getting the concentrate in eyes. In case of contact, wash thoroughly with water. If eye irritation persists, get medical attention.
