DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL PREMISE DISINFECTING: remove all filth and dirt from the premises and use a solution of one part of Disinfectant to 100 parts of water. This mixture acts as a disinfectant against *S. typhosa*.

FLOORS: When mopping or scrubbing use 2 ounces of Disinfectant to each gallon of water in the bucket.

TOILET ROOMS, WATER CLOSETS AND URINALS: Wash the closet and urinal bowls regularly with a solution made of 1/3 cupful of Disinfectant in each gallon of water, leaving the solution in the bowl as long as possible. Scrub the floor and seat frequently with this solution.

GARBAGE: To aid in preventing the breeding of flies sprinkle with the solution in the proportion of four ounces of Disinfectant to each gallon of water. Rinse the empty can with some of the solution and leave the wash in the can.

In a typhoid sick-room, in the disinfecting of beds, clothes and utensils, this Disinfectant should be used in the proportion of four ounces in each gallon of water.

CUSPIDORS: A solution of 1 ounce of Disinfectant to a gallon of water will aid in deodorizing and disinfecting cuspidors. Leave this mixture standing in the cuspidors.

DISINFECTING OF SURFACES: A solution of 1 ounce of Disinfectant to a gallon of water will aid in deodorizing and disinfecting surfaces. Leave this mixture standing on the surfaces.
