DIRECTIONS

Close windows and doors; keep closed for 10 to 15 minutes after spraying. Hold container upright, direct spray away from operator, and press button. Bedbugs—Spray bedframe, springs, mattress tufts and seams, and in all cracks and hiding places in room.

OUTDOORS: In still air, spray near ground or shrubbery to help provide temporary relief from mosquitoes, gnats and like insects.
