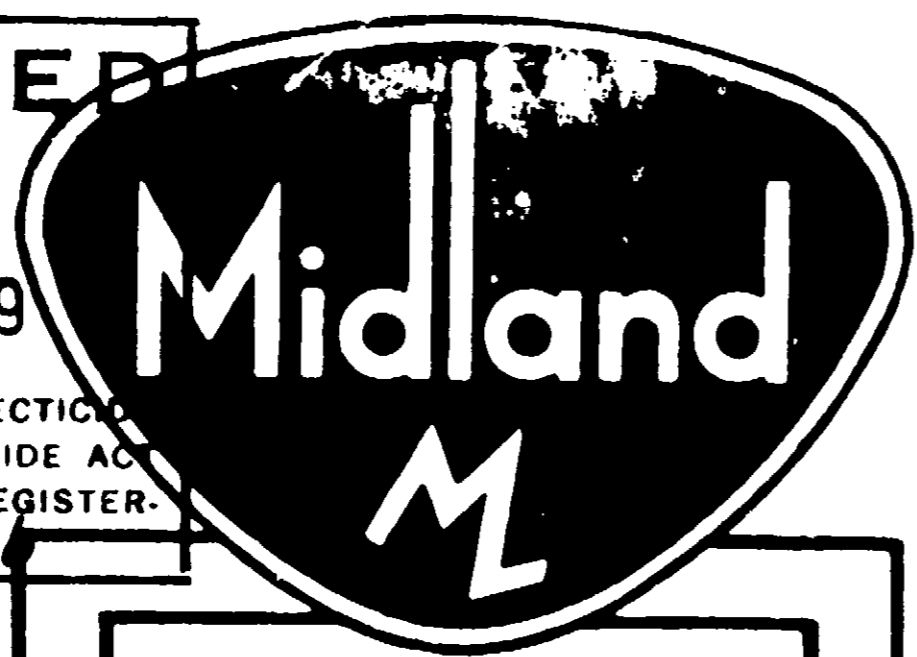

DIRECTIONS
