

FOR DAILY CLEANING OF BATH TUBS
- WASH BASINS - SHOWER STALLS -
DRINKING FOUNTAINS - Dilute cleaner
with 5 parts tap water. Rinse thoroughly
with water.

FOR DAILY CLEANING OF TILE POR-
CELAIN - Dilute cleaner with 5 parts tap
water. After cleaning, rinse with water or go
over with wet sponge or cloth.

TOILET BOWL CLEANING AND SANITIZ-
ING: To remove calcium and rust incrusta-
tions, discolorations, and other deposits:
Flush toilet, then force water over the trap
using a swab. Press swab against bowl to press
out water. Apply cleaner full strength to swab.
Swab bowl including the flush ring which
will remove rust and stains. Rinse toilet bowl
by flushing.

For removing scale, rust, and other deposits and
other discolorations from: Bath Tubs, Wash Ba-
sins, Shower Stalls, Drinking Fountains, Stainless
Steel Toilet Bowls, Urinals and other surfaces.



FOR CLEANING AND SANITIZING URI-
NALS Flush urinal, apply cleaner to scrub
and rub away discoloration and stains. Pour
one or two ounces into urinal and allow to
stand several minutes to remove odor in trap.

DANGER Harmful if swallowed. Causes eye
damage and skin irritation. In case of con-
tact with eyes, flush with plenty of water
for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, get medical
attention.

ANTIDOTE. Internal - Drink tepid water
magnesia, chalk, whiting or wall plaster, or
small pieces of soap softened in milk or raw
egg whites. External - wipe off gently, im-
mediately flood surface with water using soap
freely then cover with moist baking soda or
magnesia.

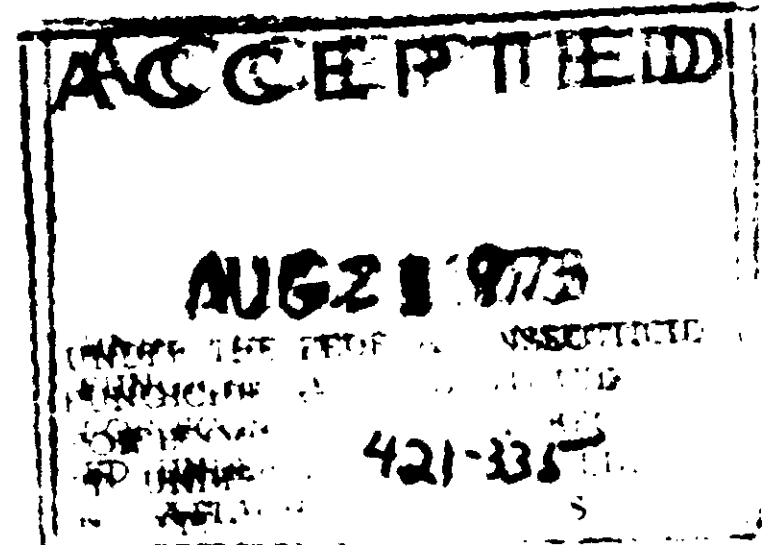
