

NET CONTENTS:

This product is specifically formulated for use as a multi-purpose liquid disinfectant cleaner and deodorant. Exerts quality cleaning, disinfecting and deodorizing properties in one operation. Recommended for cleaning and disinfecting all types of floors, walls, woodwork, furniture, kitchen equipment and other inanimate non-porous surfaces. Bathroom fixtures such as toilet bowls, urinals, wash basins, showers, etc. can be easily cleaned and disinfected.

This product is a non-volatile, non-corrosive to inanimate surfaces, and non-flammable in use dilutions.

Highly effective against a wide variety of micro-organisms. Reduces the hazard of cross contamination in buildings, factories, hospitals and institutions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For Ordinary Cleaning: To remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits: Lightly soiled areas should be cleaned with a solution containing 1 part product to 64 parts of water (2 ounces in one gallon of water). Rinse cleaned area with fresh water. Heavily soiled areas should be cleaned with a solution of 3 to 4 ounce of product per gallon. Rinse cleaned area with fresh water.

For Disinfecting and Deodorizing: For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required. Then disinfect hard, non-porous surface by applying with sponge, mop, cloth or coarse spray a fresh solution containing 1 part product to 64 parts water. Treated surfaces must remain thoroughly wet for 10 minutes. Remove excess solution. Rinse any treated food surfaces or equipment with potable water before reuse. Prepare a fresh solution daily if solution becomes visibly dirty.
