

Give a tablespoon full of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Then give two tablespoons of Epsom Salts or Milk of Magnesia in water and plenty of milk and water. Have victim lie down and keep quiet. CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY.

MOL-EX DIRECTIONS

LAWN PROTECTION FROM MOLES

If many runs prevail, roll the turf. When new runs appear insert a pointed stick into the run at intervals of about four feet. Drop a few Mol-Ex pellets into each opening and close the opening by pulling turf together. Avoid covering bait with dirt.

BULB PROTECTION FROM MOLES

To protect fall planted bulbs against destruction by moles, pack about one-quarter inch of soil against each bulb and then place several Mol-Ex pellets against the soil at the side of the bulbs, not underneath. Moles will eat Mol-Ex and be destroyed.

POCKET GOPHERS

DIRECTIONS FOR PLACING BAITS FOR POCKET GOPHER CONTROL

Burrowing pocket gophers throw out low, fan shaped mounds on either side of their underground tunnel. These lateral tunnels coming to the surface are on the flat side of the fan and are plugged with soil. With a longhandled spoon carefully remove the plug. Insert bait (teaspoonful) as far down as possible. Reclose opening.
