DIRECTIONS

Apply Zip-A-Cide with a good power, knapsack or hand machine, adjusted to give a coarse droplet spray. Treat thoroughly all surfaces of walls, ceilings, beams, pipes, containers, and other exposed areas, applying until surface is wet. Repeat as necessary.

Clean all dust and dirt from bins, storages, conveying, processing and handling equipment before treatment. Use liberally in empty bins before storage and in boxcars before loading. Sack surfaces can be sprayed until slightly moist. For controlling infestations in food products storages, spray thoroughly all exposed surfaces, then treat each layer of cartons or containers as stacked. Apply heavily to all cracks, crevices and insect harborage, hiding or breeding places.

This material should never be applied over or near an open flame. Do not spray directly on pets, livestock or growing plants. Remove or cover fish bowl or aquaria. Caged birds should be removed before spraying.

CAUTION

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

CONTAINS PETROLEUM DISTILLATE. HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED. Do not induce vomiting. Call physician.
