DIRECTIONS

For the sick room, all utensits, such as bedpans, etc., wash with a solution of two ounces disinfectant in one gallon, or one tablespoonful per quart of water.

For floors, when mopping or scrubbing, use three ounces disinfectant in one gallon, or one and one-half tablespoonful per quart of water.

For water closets and urinals, use four ounces disinfectant in one gallon, or two tablespoonfuls per quart of water. Apply freely to all surfaces to be disinfected and flush drain pipes with the solution.

QUINT-A-CIDE is made with pure st eam distilled pine oil and contains no synthetics.
