Coarse sprays are less likely to drift. Increase spray volumes by increasing nozzle size orifice diameter rather than by adding more nozzles or increasing nozzle pressure.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

RE-ENTRY STATEMENT

Do not apply this product in a manner as to expose workers or other persons either directly or through drift. The area being treated must be vacated by unprotected persons. Do not enter or allow entry into treated areas within 24 hours after treatment unless protective clothing is worn. State or local reentry regulations may be more restrictive than those stated on this label. Areas that have been treated with this product shall be posted at the usual points of entry with the following posting statement in an acceptable language:

RECOMMENDED FOR THE CONTROL OF THE FOLLOWING: Black spot and powdery mildew on roses; powdery mildew on chrysanthemums and lilacs; rust on chrysanthemums and beans; common red spider on beans, cotton, evergreens and peas; for thrips, citrus red spider and two-spotted mite on citrus fruits.

NOTE TO USER:

Do not use within 2 weeks of an oil spray treatment; on citrus within 30 days.

Sulfur may burn foliage if applied when temperature is high (90 to 95°F). Do not make application at this time.

FOR USE AS A LIQUID SPRAY

For a gallon of spray, mix 3 tablespoonfuls of DURHAM'S WETTABLE DUSTING SULFUR with an equal amount of water and stir into a thick paste, then add water slowly, stirring constantly until the gallon of water has been thoroughly combined. Apply with ordinary sprayer. Keep well stirred at all times.

FOR USE AS A DUST

DURHAM'S WETTABLE DUSTING SULFUR is all ready for use as it comes in the package. This package is furnished with punch-out holes on the top for dusting direct from the package or use a hand duster procurable at your local dealer.

WHEN TO APPLY

Apply early in the morning or cool of the evening when the air is still. Thoroughly cover all stems, leaves and blossoms on both upper and lower surfaces. As a fungicide, frequent applications should be made early in the season. During the summer and fall, application should be made at 10 day intervals. As an insecticide, apply carefully when the insects threaten and repeat every few days until the pests are eliminated.

COMMON CHIGGER CONTROL

For the control of chiggers in the yard, dust Durham's Wettable Dusting Sulfur over the entire lawn, flower garden, shrubs and any place the chiggers may be hiding. This should be done a day or two before protection is desired and should be repeated at weekly intervals. The contents of this package will cover from 1500 to 2000 square feet. Dust on clothing, especially around the legs when visiting chigger-infested areas.
