**RE-ENTRY STATEMENT**

Do not apply this product in a manner as to expose workers or other persons either directly or through drift. The areas being treated must be vacated by unprotected persons. Do not enter or allow entry into treated areas within 24 hours after treatment unless protective clothing is worn.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.  
Storage: Store product in its original container in a cool, dry, locked place out of reach of children.  
Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

**NOTE TO USER**

Do not use within 2 weeks of an oil spray treatment on citrus within 30 days. Sulphur may burn foliage if applied when temperature is high (90 to 95°F). Do not make application at this time.

DURHAM'S COMMERCIAL DUSTING SULFUR is ready for use as it comes in the package. This package is furnished with punch-out holes on the top for dusting direct from the package or use a hand duster procurable at your local dealer.

**WHEN TO APPLY**

**POWDERY MILDEW ON CREPE MYRTLE, EUONYMUS AND PHLOX:** Dust with dusting sulfur covering both upper and lower surface of the leaves at the first sign of the disease or when white or grayish growth begins to cover the upper surface of the leaves on crepe myrtle and phlox and when white spots or blotches appear on both sides of euonymus. Repeat as needed for control.

Apply early in the morning or cool of the evening when the air is still. Thoroughly cover all stems, leaves and blossoms on both upper and lower surfaces. As a fungicide, frequent applications should be made early in the season. During the summer and fall, applications should be made at 10 day intervals. As an insecticide, apply carefully when the insects threaten and repeat every few days until the pests are eliminated.

**COMMON CHIGGER CONTROL**

For the control of chiggers in the yard, dust DURHAM'S COMMERCIAL DUSTING SULFUR over the entire lawn, flower garden, shrubs and any place the chiggers may be hiding. This should be done a day or two before protection is desired and should be repeated at weekly intervals. The contents of this package will cover 2000 square feet. Dust on clothing, especially around the legs when visiting chigger-infested areas.
