DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with these directions.

ON HORSES AND PONIES

Brush the animal thoroughly to remove loose dirt and dust. Prepare the appropriate dilution of Pyrenone Stabilene E.C. in the amount of one quart per horse. Diluted Pyrenone Stabilene E.C. should be used with water.

To Kill and Repel House Flies, Horn Flies, Gnats, and Mosquitoes: Dilute with water.

To Kill and Repel Horse Flies, Stable Flies, Deer Flies and Face Flies: Dilute with water.

Moisten (do not soak) a folded 12" square piece of turkish toweling with the diluted Pyrenone Stabilene E.C. Rub against, then with hair growth. Give special attention to facial areas, where the flies are most often seen. Avoid contact with eyes or nostrils. If desired, the sheen of the coat may be enhanced by light brushing following application of Pyrenone Stabilene E.C. daily.

To Kill Fleas and Lice: Using a dilution of 1 part concentrate to 49 parts water, thoroughly wet the skin of the animal. Repeat treatment as necessary. Thoroughly spray premises and sleeping quarters, paying particular attention to areas where the animals sleep.

To Kill Attached Ticks: Saturate a cloth with the concentrate and dab directly on the ticks.

IN HORSE BARN, STABLE AND TACK ROOMS. To control flies, mosquitoes and gnats, mix 1 part concentrate to 24 parts water or oil and apply as a fog or fine mist in the corners until the area is filled with mist using about 2 ounces per gallon. For best results, close doors and windows before spraying and keep them closed until the area is ventilated before reoccupying. Repeat application as necessary.

USE AS A WATER SPRAY: 1-9 Dilution: Mix 1 quart of emulsifiable concentrate with 9 parts water to make 2 2/3 gallons of spray. Stir before using. Apply at the rate of 1 quart per animal, depending on the size of the animal.

Horn Flies, Mosquitoes, and Gnats: Apply as necessary to give continued protection.

Stable Flies and House Flies: Apply as necessary to give continued protection.

Horse Flies and Deer Flies: Apply as necessary to give continued protection.

This dilution will kill horse flies, stable flies, house flies, horn flies, mosquitoes and gnats.

1-14 Dilution: Mix 1 quart of emulsifiable concentrate Pyrenone Stabilene E.C. with 14 parts water to make 3 gallons of spray. Stir before using. Apply at the rate of 1 pint to 1 quart per animal, depending on the size of the animal.

Horn Flies, Mosquitoes, and Gnats: Apply as necessary to give continued protection.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE AND SPILL PROCEDURES: Store upright at room temperature. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as sawdust, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be reused must be disposed of at or by an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Empty hose (or equivalent) then offer for recycling and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and local authority.

CONTAINERS ONE GALLON AND SMALLER: Do not reuse container for any other purpose.
