ON PETS

Start spraying at the tail, moving rapidly and making sure that the animal is covered, including the legs and feet. While spraying, fluff the hair so that spray reaches to the skin. Make sure spray wets the animal. Do not spray into eyes or face. Repeat as necessary.

ON PREMISES

To control fleas and brown dog ticks, thoroughly spray infested areas, pet quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, baseboards, mouldings, window and door frames. Localized areas of floor and floor bedding should be placed in animal quarters. Concurrent treatment of humans is recommended. Repeat treatment as necessary.
